**2,45m HIGH SECURITY FENCE WITH 0,45m OVERHANG**

- Old fencing and poles must be removed, except for the two post and gates at the main entrance
- New fencing boundary need to be optimally layout to ensure that there is no need to excavate the old concrete base and must have a marginal offset to the current footprint.
- Four (4) strands of 3,15mm diameter straining wires tied/bolted to posts, etc [4off x 465m]
- Three (3) strands of 3,15mm diameter single strand barbed wires tied/bolted to posts, etc [3off x 465m]
- 2m High x 50mm mesh galvanized chain link fencing (diamond mesh) formed of 2,5mm diameter wire, bound to straining wires with 2mm galvanized binding wire [465m]
- 50mm Diameter x 2mm wall thickness galvanized cranked tubular intermediate posts 3,05m girth at 3m centres, inserted into ground with cover not less than 600mm and concrete base 450mm thick. Included a welded lug 40x40x5 with a 12mm hole in the centre of the lug, the lug must be welded 650mm from the base of the post and will be used for earthing. [145off]
- 76mm Diameter x 3mm wall thickness galvanized cranked tubular corner and straining posts 3,05m girth at not exceeding 90m centres inserted into ground with cover not less than 600mm and concrete base 450mm thick. [9off]
- 50mm Diameter x 2mm wall thickness galvanized tubular strays 2,6m long fixed to straining, corner and gate posts, inserted into ground with cover not less than 600mm and concrete base 450mm thick and bolted at top with and including 12mm diameter galvanized bolt. [18off]
- 12mm Diameter x 300mm long galvanized eyebolts are required to tighten straining and barbed wires. [70off]
