- South African tenderers must be registered on the CSD (National Treasury Central Supplier Database). **The buyer shall verify registration on the National Treasury Supplier Data Base (CSD). If the tenderer is found not to be registered the tender shall be rendered commercially non-responsive.**
- Tenderer to meet the eligibility criteria as per **2.1 on page 7 of the Invitation to Tender Document**
- Tenderer to submit the original tender document PLUS ONE (1) exact hard copy of the original tender.
- Submission of the mandatory commercial tender returnables at stipulated deadlines. Only tenders submitted at the correct location and correct closing date and time will be accepted.

The following mandatory pre-qualification criteria are applicable herein: -

- 1. Panel A:** Only suppliers with a minimum **B-BBEE status level 1 to 4**
- 2. Panel B:** Only **EME/QSE** with a minimum **BBBEE status Level 1 to 2**

“proof of B-BBEE status level must be submitted at tender submission deadline.

A Certified Copy of a Valid B-BBEE Certificate issued by a SANAS accredited Verification Agency

A Certified Copy of a fully completed Sworn Affidavit, or A Certified Copy of B-BBEE Certificate issued by CIPC for EMEs

- Refer to page 17 to 20 of the Invitation to Tender Document for the list of mandatory returnable documents
- **All documents listed and marked with √ in the “Returnable documents mandatory for evaluation purposes and due at tender closing” column, must be submitted with the tender to be evaluated further.**
- The mandatory tender returnable documents as stipulated in the invitation to tender document must be printed, completed, signed and be inserted in the commercial returnable file.
- **If any of these documents are not FULLY completed, signed and submitted, the tender will be disqualified**

Once the suppliers have met the afore-mentioned requirements they will then be evaluated for technical.

- **Multiple contracts by way of a panel will be established with a maximum of 40 suppliers with a split of 15 for Panel A and 25 for Panel B Environmental Services.**
- **The highest 15 ranked suppliers for Panel A and highest 25 ranked suppliers for Panel B will be awarded contracts. Mini RFQ's will then be issued for each Task Order on an “as and when required” basis and the adjudication thereof will be done via a Panel Control Committee**
- **A 40/60 (40% Panel A & 60% Panel B) of the total budget is allocated to the panels.**
- **The award of the split to the various panel contractors will be in proportion to the outcome of the Preferential Point Scoring system (80/20 or 90/10)**
