Please indicate whether this is:</p> <p>(i) Due to Eskom not expecting the bid price to exceed R 30 million OR</p> <p>(ii) If the bid price is expected to exceed R 30 million, Eskom deeming sub-contracting to NOT be feasible.</p> <p>If the bid price is, however, expected to exceed R 30 million and sub-contracting is feasible (as appears to be the case from the documentation) please confirm that the mandatory sub-contracting requirement of 30% of the work in accordance with Regulation 9 of the PPPFA Regulations is applicable. If not applicable, please confirm whether Eskom has obtained the required approvals/waivers in this regard.</p>	<p>1.
