1. SPECIFICATIONS

- Contractor will perform the Services according to a schedule that will be agreed upon with Eskom health manager.
- Contractor must be able to hold the key, unlock and relock the containers without direct supervision. (Locked Cabinet)
- Contractor accepts legal title to the waste received from Eskom.
- Upon completion of pick up and new container delivery, Contractor must provide a properly completed, signed and dated manifest with the OHN of each Facility.
- Contractor shall deliver biohazardous materials to a licensed infections waste disposal centre and safely dispose of pharmaceutical prescription drugs.
- Contractor must be available to provide the Services during Eskom regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 14h00 p.m. excluding holidays.
- If Contractor is unable to collect containers on a schedule date for reasons beyond its control, Eskom must be notified as soon as possible, but in any event no later than 13.00 p.m. on the same day.
- Eskom may require emergency Services outside of the regular schedule. If such an occasion shall arise, it is requested that Contractor pick up the container(s) within 24hrs after notification
- Compass Waste will be required to fax and post certificate of destruction immediately to Eskom once waste been incinerated.

EMPLOYER'S REQUIREMENTS:

- Collection of HCRW using an approved medical waste collection vehicle to approved and registered waste disposal facility.
- Collection of waste will be on once a month for service basis by the HCRW generator. Weigh of waste on collection and provision of waste manifest to the generator.
- Provision of invoice within 14 days from the date of collection.
- Supply of sharp containers (temper and puncture proof).
- Supply of pharmaceutical containers.
- Supply of biohazard tapes.
- Supply of infectious HCRW boxes with rigid and leak proof plastics as and when required.
- Turnaround time for collection and supply is 72 hrs of working days maximum.

4.SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

4.1 COMPLIANCE

Must comply with the ff:

- ✓ Registered on SAWIC, GWIS and IPWIS systems.
- ✓ Member of the Institute of Waste Management of Southern Africa.
- ✓ Letter of Good Standing with the Compensation Commissioner.
- ✓ HCRW containers are SABS tested and approved, correctly colour-coded and labelled.
- ✓ Comply with the UN Recommendations for the Transportation of Dangerous Goods.

- ✓ Trade Effluent permit for the washing of HCRW vehicles and reusable containers.
- ✓ Regular microbial testing conducted on vehicles and reusable containers.
- ✓ External audits of treatment facilities conducted every six months, including sterility testing of the treated waste.
- ✓ All vehicles shall be:
 - licensed with the Department of Transport as dangerous goods carriers.
 - equipped with spill kits and fire extinguishers and comply with the National Road Traffic Act
- ✓ (No 93 of 1996) and Regulations for transporting HCRW.
- ✓ All vehicles have the correct signage identifying that they are carrying HCRW.
- ✓ Drivers have Professional Dangerous Goods Driver permits and SETA accredited Hazchem training.
- ✓ Staff are provided with the correct personal protective equipment (PPE) for handling HCRW.
