### **The scope of work includes the following:**

Replacing critically damaged roof cover plates, handrails and structural components used to secure the rails to the tank sidewalls.

The Contractor performs a comprehensive repair of the failed roof section of the Fire Water Tank. The Contractor performs comprehensive repairs on the critically damaged handrails and associated structural supports and attachments. The works take place on site at the location of the Fire Water Tank as seen on Drawing 0.85/367 Rev P0 – Gourikwa OCGT Layout. The works includes deconstruction of the current damaged roof cover plates, handrails and associated structural supports and attachments. Activities of work include:

- **Rigging:** Removal of damaged cover plates using a hydraulic truck mounted crane
- **Cutting, fitting and placement:** perform cutting (grinding), drilling and fitting for installing handrails and cover plates.
- **Waterproofing:** Sealing of side panels and cover plates.
- **Testing:** to prove the integrity of the work performed

The Contractor is wholly responsible for the deconstruction of invalidated structural components including the cover plates, handrails and associated supports and fasteners. Furthermore, the contractor is wholly responsible for reconstruction of the Fire Water Tank to its original state, surface preparation and galvanising application.

### **Deconstruction of the invalidated components**

#### ➤ **The Contractor will deconstruct the Fire Water Tank Cover Plates**

- Remove damaged cover plates from Fire Water Tank using a hydraulic truck mounted crane.
- Undo M12 bolts that secures individual damaged cover plates on overlapping joints.
- Salvage all reusable cover plates and store on site.
- Safely remove invalidated cover plates from work site or relocate to lay down yard.

#### ➤ **Removal of Hand railings**

- Erect scaffolding, spanning 15 m, along the Eastern Wall of the Fire Water Tank up to a height of 4 to 5 meters in order to provide a safe, ergonomic working platform.
- Undo Slip joints and remove 33 [mm] diameter Hand railings from stanchions starting from one side working across the designated area.
- Unbolt M12 Nuts located on the kicker plates in order to free stanchions from Fire Water Tank, it is not required to remove the M16 bolts located on the stanchion palms
- Hand railings on the Eastern wall of the Fire Water Tank (As shown in Appendix E) shall be removed.
- Safely store hand railing sections and stanchions on site
- Safely dispose of invalidated hand railings and stanchions

#### ➤ **Removal of CAT Ladder**

- Unscrew M12 Bolts from CAT Ladder Cleats
- Safely dispose of Cat Ladder

### **Reconstruction of Fire Water Tank roof**

#### ➤ **Damaged side panels:**

- The four to five damaged side panels as shown in Appendix C is of minor concern since the structural integrity of the tank is not compromised by the slight bend. The only concern will be to have a horizontal top plane in order to secure the stanchions on the Eastern side of the Fire Water Tank

#### ➤ **Covering the Fire Water Tank top**

- Remove critically damaged L Channel sections from the side panels.
- Dispose of L Channel sections in the lay down yard.
- Install new 3mm thick galvanised steel L Channel along the length of the Eastern Walls of the Fire Water Tank using high tensile grade galvanised M12 bolts, washers and nuts.
- Fit required amount of cover plates and seal using silicone or mastic compound in order to close up the Fire Water Tank roof.

- Secure individual cover plates to one another using high tensile grade galvanised M12 Bolts, washers and nuts.
- Reinforce Row 1 and Row 24 with galvanised angle iron to secure roof to sidewalls.
- Secure reinforced end cover plates to L Channels using high tensile grade galvanised roofing screws
- Close up small gap resulting from bent side panels by cutting a custom shape cover plate that will ensure a complete roof seal.

#### ➤ **Fitting the hand rails**

- Bolt kicker plates to L Channels using high tensile grade galvanised M12 bolts, washers and nuts
- When reinstalling the handrails on the bent side panels: bend the kick plates to the correct acute angle which will ensure stanchions are installed 90° [deg] relative to the Fire Water Tank roof
- Fasten stanchion palms to kicker plates using high tensile grade galvanised M16 bolts, washers and nuts
- Install hand railings to resemble original specification
- Handrails shall be according to Eskom Standard for Stair and Handrails drawing number 2901 Rev 9.

#### ➤ **Installation of the CAT ladder**

- Fit a 5m CAT ladder to Fire Water Tank on the Eastern side wall, as per Eskom Standard for Stair and Handrails drawing number 2901 Rev 9.

### **Specification of Product or Goods**

#### **Materials**

Steel components are manufactured from carbon steel.

#### **Tank Panels**

Material	High Yield stress drawing quality, Carbon Steel
Size	1220 [mm] x 1220 [mm]
Available Thickness	3 [mm], 4.5 [mm] or 6 [mm]

The tank has a 1000[m<sup>3</sup>] storage capacity and dimensions are shown in Appendix A. Refer to Appendix B for recommended thickness and Panel Views.

#### **Cover Plates**

Cover plates are shaped to provide a tight overlapping fit. Refer to Appendix B for a schematic representation of the cover plates.

#### **Internal Bracing and Roof Supports**

Internal bracing and roof supports are designed and manufactured to provide a rigid structure. Most Items are jig assembled for dimensional precision. The Internal bracing and Roof Supports will remain as is and no repairs are required on this.

#### **Fasteners:**

All bolts and nuts are high tensile grade

#### **Corrosion Protection**

All steel components are hot dip galvanised to internationally recognised standards ISO 1461:2009 after manufacture.

#### **Sealing Materials**

Special profile rubber gaskets are used between tank plates. Rubber bungs, silicone and mastic compound are used at other specific places. All sealing materials are non-toxic and non-tainting

#### **Pipe Connections**

Pipe connections are welded to tank plates at supplier works before galvanising. Standard types of connections are BSP screwed sockets and flanges on stub pipes. Preferred flanges are to SABS 1123 100Kpa or BS 4509 10 Bar.
