Everything needs to be priced for upfront, so that Eskom can evaluate and contract for total solutions implementation including the Maintenance and support for a contract period of 5 years and 9 months. **Both** the barcoding and RFID solution must be provided as a turnkey solution for the design, development, testing (unit test, system integration testing, regression test, user acceptance testing, performance test, disaster recovery testing, vulnerability test, security test etc.), integration, training, and deployment of the solutions. RFID and Barcoding are both part of the scope and will be implemented in parallel to each other.
