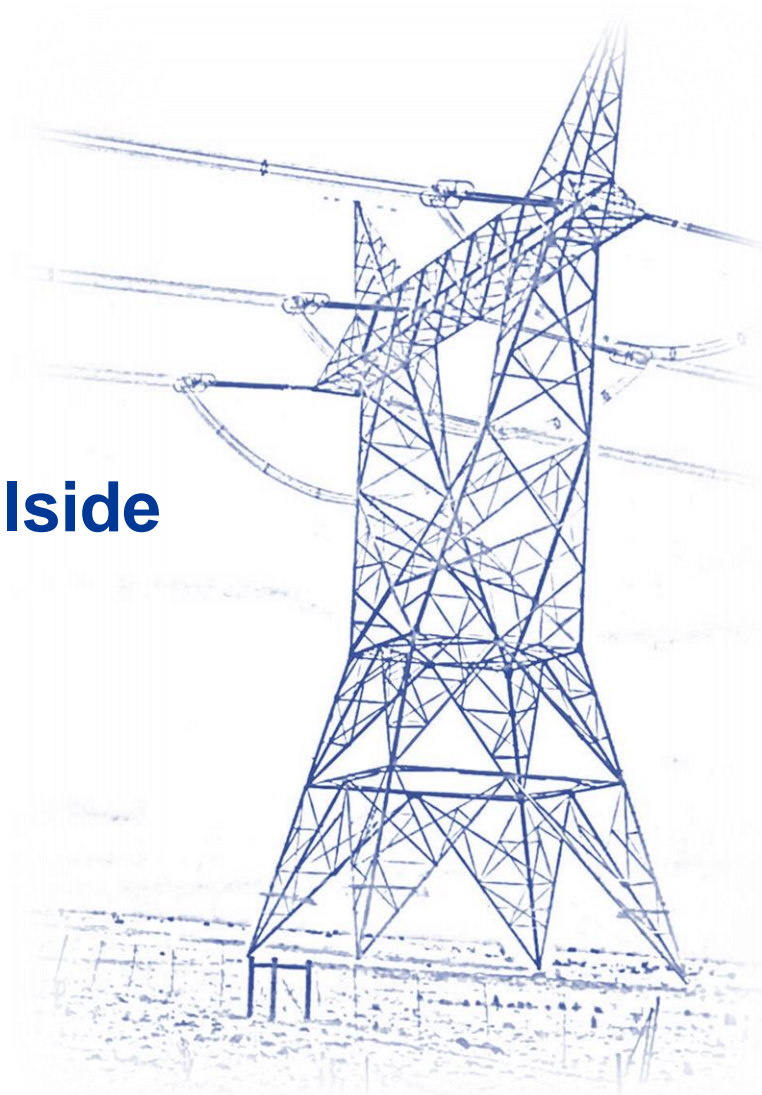


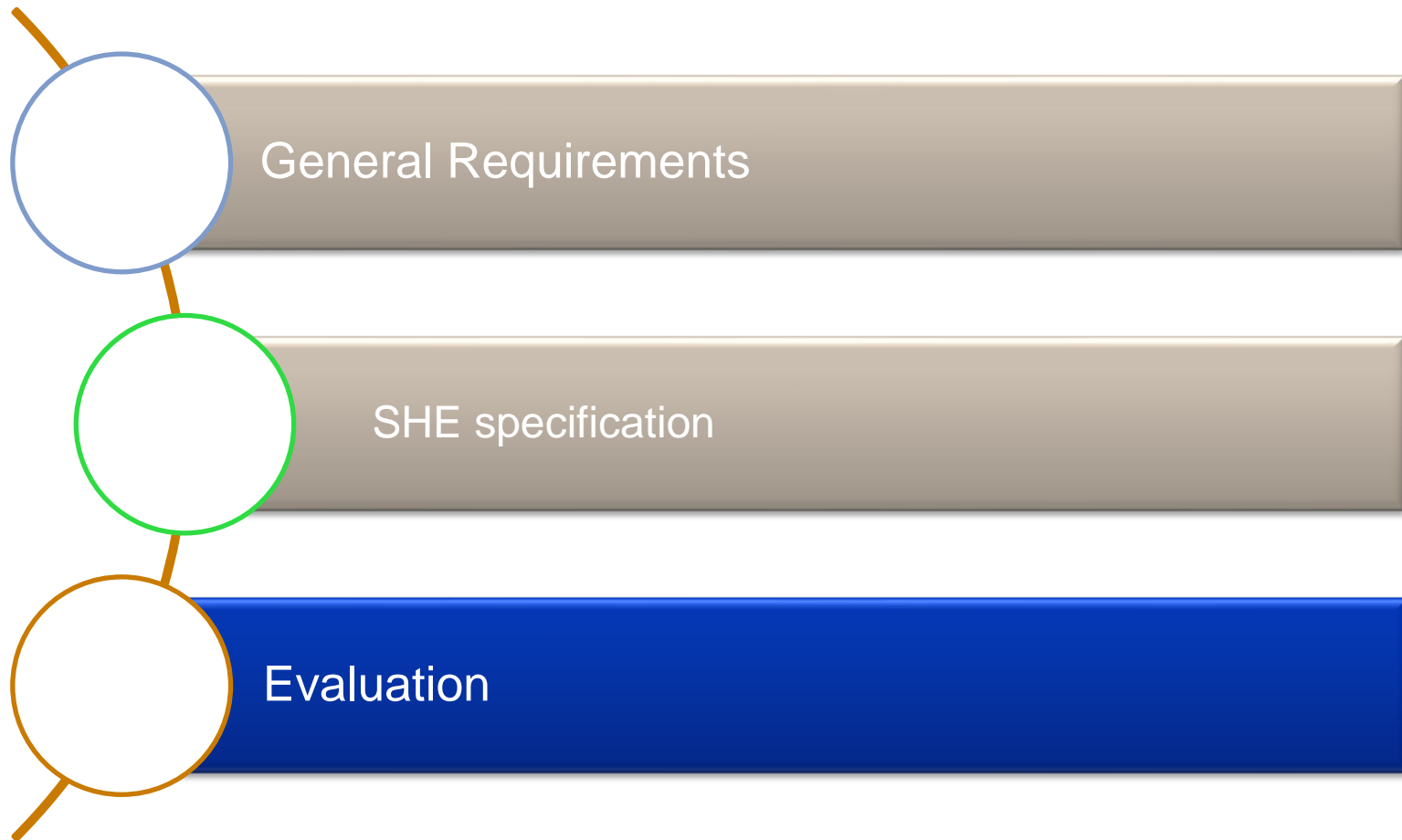

- Construction work is regulated by the OHS ACT 85 of 1993 and applicable regulations.
- Before tendering for any work OHS ACT 85 of 1993 and applicable regulations i.e. construction regulations needs to be considered.
- Eskom develops OHS specification to be considered by the contractors that will be bidding for the work as **minimum requirements.**
- Eskom aims for zero harm and zero incidents.
- Contractor is expected to demonstrate compliance with the laws of the country in order to achieve the goal of zero incidents.

- A detailed and project specific OHS files get to be evaluated in line with the requirements tabled in the OHS specification (shared with the contractor as tender returns).
- A high-risk work evaluation template is used (shared with the contractor as tender returns).
- OHS evaluation is undertaken to the contractors that have passed technical requirements to assess compliance with the minimum requirements.
- Contractors that have passed technical requirements get to be evaluated again for site readiness if they have been awarded the contract.
