# Roles and Responsibilities of a Supplier



To provide valid and authentic documentation for assessment during tender.

Each site or premises of Eskom and its subsidiaries may have various OHS requirements, and it is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure that those requirements are met.

To comply with, and continuously adhere to all OHS legislations, Eskom and other requirements all the time while doing business with Eskom Holdings SOC or any of its subsidiaries.

To seek clarity and pose questions during this meeting.

To ensure that he/she registers on the Eskom contractor portal on the website as advised by the responsible Eskom representative, SD&L.

***NB: approval from one cluster/ tender does not warrant automatic recommendations for contract award, even where similar nature of scope applies.***

Where applicable - All commercial and technical compliant contractors will be afforded an opportunity ONLY ONCE, a period not exceeding 7 business days to resubmit any outstanding requirements from the first evaluations.

No clarification gathering/ meeting or teleconferencing will be held one on one basis with the supplier after the communication letters are sent for resubmission of outstanding documents.

Failure to submit by the deadline and failure to meet all SHEQ requirements shall render the tender/s non-responsive.
