	0,00-0,70m	Abundant sub-angular to sub-rounded weathered and fresh quartzite GRAVELS, COBBLES and BOULDERS densely packed in a matrix of yellowish brown SILTY SAND; overall consistency dense; pebble marker.	
	0,70-2,50m	Slightly moist, pinkish brown, in profile pale yellowish brown, banded and blotched orange and reddish brown, stiff, horizontally bedded and jointed (stained black), SANDY SILT with occasional hard and friable gravel and cobble sized clasts and very stiff ferruginised pockets; residual Dwyka tillite.	
	2,50-4,60m+	Slightly moist to moist, pale grey, in profile pale grey blotched yellow and orange, stiff, jointed (stained black), slightly CLAYEY SANDY SILT with occasional gravel to boulder sized soft and hard rock clasts and thin very stiff ferruginised lenses; residual Dwyka tillite.
