

	<div>0,00-0,50m Abundant angular, weathered shale GRAVELS in matrix of yellowish brown SILTY SAND; overall consistency medium dense; roots; pebble marker.</div> <div>0,50-1,80m Dry, pinkish brown, in profile pinkish brown banded yellowish brown and black, laminated and jointed (stained yellow and black), very stiff, CLAY-SILT with occasional small (up to 100mm diameter) soft rock feruginised pockets; residual Rayton shale.</div> <div>1,80-2,80m Pinkish brown banded yellowish brown and black, jointed (stained yellow and black) and laminated, very soft rock, highly weathered Rayton shale. Shale dips about 15° in a westerly direction.</div>
